Dishwashing liquid. Polishes dishes and does not leave any streaks and stains. Has a PZH certificate. Does not cause irritation and does not dry out the skin. Dermatologically tested.

APPLICATION:

- kitchen dishes

COMPOSITION:

5-15% anionic surfactants, <5% non-ionic surfactants, perfumes (Limonene, Citral, Hexyl Cinnamal), preservation agent (DMDM Hydantoin, Methylchloroisothiazolinone, Methylisothiazolinone)

USAGE:

working solution: 10-50 ml / 1 l of water; old and dried grease: 100 ml / 1 l of water;

water temperature: 30 - 40°C; wash everything down with running water;

can be used without dilution..
