Product designed for hygienic antiseptics and hands disinfecting in food industry and gastronomy. Shows bactericidal properties. Cumulates in epidermis which prolongs its effect (about 3h). Destroys germs residing in the deeper layers of the skin.

Contains oiling and moisturizing substances which prevents drying of the hands and preserves their flexibility.

Product has Certificate of the National Institute of Hygiene – PZH (HŻ/2356/2012).

Product dermatologically tested.

### **APPLICATION:**

- contact with food (gastronomy, food industry)
- medical practices (health services)

### **COMPOSITION:**

100 ml of the product includes:

- 2.2g chlorhexidine digluconate
- 58g isopropanol
- auxiliary substances not classified as dangerous

### **USAGE:**

Before using, read product's safety data sheet.

Do not dilute it with water.

Hands disinfection: Rub 3ml of the product into your hands for 30 seconds.

This time is synonymous with double repeat of the process.

Leave it to dry off on its own.

#### **DANGER:**



- Flammable liquid and vapour
  - Causes serious eye irritation
  - May cause drowsiness or dizziness.

- Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flames and other ignition sources. No smoking.
  - IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.

#### **SELL-BY DATE:**

12 months from the production date.

Production date/series and expiration date are stated on the packaging.

#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

Additional information can be found in safety data sheet.

Contaminated containers should be completely emptied. Several times rinse the container promptly after emptying. Empty container can be stored in containers for collection of plastic packaging, or can be delivered to specialized company for recycling.

Disposal should be in accordance with the national/international regulations
