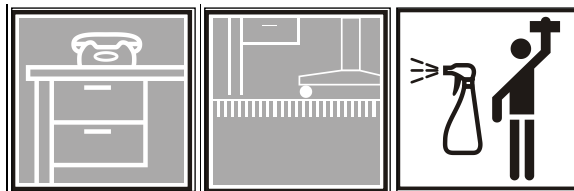


PUNKT MULTI CLEANER

Specialistic product based on natural dissolvents and alcohols, designed for removing local impurities from markers insoluble in water, bubble gum, glue from self-adhesive labels, bitumen, rubber stains, plasticine, paraffin etc.

Warning: Dissolves rubber surfaces, soft plastic and non-original car paint.

APPLICATION:

- car bodies
- offices, houses, locker rooms, waiting rooms
- hard floors, carpet coverings

COMPOSITION:

- < 50% alcohols
- < 15% orange terpene
- < 50% propan and butan mixture

USAGE:

Read product's safety data sheet before using.

Use product without diluting.

Spray the contaminated spot on the surface, wait a moment and clean it with brush or cloth. In case of uneven surfaces, apply the product on the surface, wait a moment, brush it and collect the dirt with cloth.

Warning: Before using, test the colour and surface durability.
Do not use on rubber, soft plastic and acrylic glass.

DANGER:



- Extremely flammable aerosol.
 - Pressurised container: May burst if heated.
