


GRAN DIW

Technical Data Sheet



Highly alkaline, low-foaming product, designed for using in dishwashers. Recommended for glass, ceramic and aluminum dishes. Dampens dishes which easily removes food leftovers. Product contains anticorrosive effects, which prevents damaging them and it also prevents plastic dishes from yellowing. Odourless. Product has Certificate of the National Institute of Hygiene – PZH (HŻ/02091/04/2012).

APPLICATION:

- dishwashers in gastronomic institutions, hotels, restaurants, schools, bars etc.

COMPOSITION:

- 15-30% EDTA sodium salt
- < 15% sodium hydroxide
- < 5% phosphonates
- auxiliary substances not classified as dangerous

USAGE:

Before using, read product's safety data sheet.

Concentration according to the dishwasher's cycle is about 10-30 ml / 10 l of water. Minimal temperature of water is 40-60°C.

- Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.
- Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.
- IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting.
- IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water [or shower].
- IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
- Immediately call a POISON CENTER/doctor
- Store locked up.

SELL-BY DATE:

36 months from the production date. Production date/series and expiration date are stated on the packaging.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Additional information can be found in safety data sheet.

Contaminated containers should be completely emptied. Several times rinse the container promptly after emptying. Empty container can be stored in containers for collection of plastic packaging, or can be delivered to specialized company for recycling.

Disposal should be in accordance with the national/international regulations
